

**Samobor Tour (with Wine-tasting) - Day excursion from Zagreb - 2020**

**Samobor town sightseeing (town center + vantage point)  
Grgos cave visit – Lunch | **Optional: Wine-tasting****

Around 9.00am we leave your Zagreb hotel and drive to Samobor Town (40 minutes' drive from Zagreb), and climb up to the Samobor's most beautiful vantage point 'Steel Tower' (30 minutes walking uphill). This walk is through pure nature – forest and clean air!

On top of the tower it's beautiful view over Samobor Town and Zagreb. Samobor 'Old town' (fort), built in 13<sup>th</sup> century, is visible, too. There we would have 'welcome schnapps' (home-made fruit schnapps). After tower visit, we come down to Samobor center and have short town sightseeing (approx. 45 minutes).

Samobor is small, charming town, often called – 'Little Venice' (with miniature bridges over river and houses built right next to the river). From their balconies they can jump into the river. Main Square has very impressive architecture from 18-19<sup>th</sup> cent.



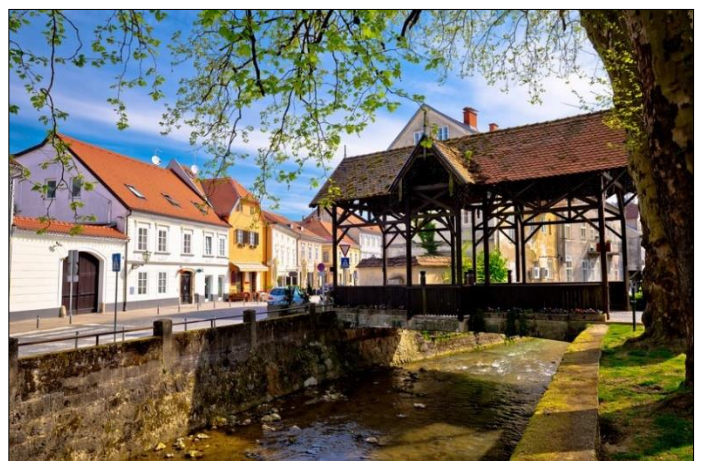

After Samobor sightseeing we would drive to Grgos cave (10 minutes' drive) and do cave visit (15-20 minutes walking inside the cave). The cave is geomorphologic phenomenon of 'Karst' rocks. It's accidentally discovered by Grgos family, when they excavated raw materials (limestone).

**Note: It is cold inside the cave (~10C/50F), you should have jacket or shirt with long sleeves.**

After cave visit, we would stay there for lunch. Next to the cave is restaurant 'At the cave' with excellent local food and wine.

Leaving restaurant, we would drive to Plesivica hills. There is famous Plesivica wine road, and we would visit family Korak or Jagunić, local wine-makers. There we will have wine tasting – 4 different wines.

After wine tasting, we would go back to your hotel (40 minutes' drive). **Total tour time: ~ 8 hours**

**Tour price:**

- **2 people - 125 EUR per person (car)**

- **4-8 people - 110 EUR per person (mini-van)**

**Included:** transportation, Samobor guided tour (+ maps & brochures), hiking to 'steel tower', welcome schnapps, Grgos cave visit, lunch at restaurant '**At the cave**'

- home-made soup
- grilled 'Samobor style' trout
- grilled fresh vegetables
- glass of red or white wine/beer/juice

**2) Meat menu**

- home-made soup
- cooked veal, potatoes and vegetables
- mixed salad
- glass of red or white wine/beer/juice

**Optional:** wine-tasting in 'Plesivica hills' wine-road. Plesivica hills are painted in nice scenery, too!

**Included:** scenic drive through vineyards, wine cellar visit, wine-tasting (4 wines), snacks
