

**Split Multi-day Private Tour - 2021**

**Split – Primošten – Trogir– Hvar island**

| Plitvice Lakes NP visit | **OPTIONAL: Split → Dubrovnik transfer**

**Tour includes transfer from Zagreb to Split via Plitvice Lakes NP.** It's perfect way to see & feel half of Croatia's landscape/biodiversity - in just one day! All locations, attractions, restaurants, and hideaways I've visited and checked personally. I can promise you easy-going time and plenty of fun...

**Day 1 • Split**

Around 9.30am we would start Split sightseeing tour (*Diocletian palace*, built in 4<sup>th</sup> century – UNESCO WH site; 'Riva' – Promenade; farmers market & fish market, viewpoint 'Vidilica' with coffee break).  
Sightseeing – approx. 2 hours.

After sightseeing, I'll take you to local fish restaurant '*Konoba Fetivi*' for lunch, where locals eat. You're free in the afternoon to explore rest of Split, soaking up the atmosphere and city's good vibes.

**Note:** lunch is not included in the tour price.

**Day 2 • Primošten town & Trogir town (UNESCO WH) • Day Trip**

Around 9.30am we would leave Split and go to Primošten town. Along the way, we would stop in 'Babich' vineyards, location 'Bucavac' (above the marina 'Kremik'). Picture of 'Babich' vineyards used to hang in



UN headquarters in Geneva (as a symbol of hard human labor). After 'Babich' vineyards visit, we would continue to town of Primošten and have sightseeing walk and coffee.

Leaving Primošten, we're heading to Seget Donji town to have lunch in fish restaurant (local food & wine).

After the lunch, we'll drive to beautiful Renaissance/Baroque Trogir town, listed as UNESCO WH site. Sightseeing – circa 1 hour.

### **Cooking class & Lunch**

If available, we would have lunch in Trogir town, instead in Seget Donji. I have a partner in Trogir, who organizes cooking classes there. We wouldn't do whole class, you would help with just one part of cooking (grilling). This is interesting way to learn more about Croatian (Dalmatian) cuisine and taste a home-made meal (fresh ingredients). Of course, local schnapps and wine is a – must!

After slow food lunch and local wine, we would go back to Split. When we return to Split, rest of the evening you are free.

**Note:** Sea-food lunch is not included in the tour price. It's extra, circa **25 EUR** per person

### **Day 3 • Hvar Island & 'Pakleni' Archipelago • Day Trip**

I'll meet you in Split harbor around **7.20am** and we would walk to ferry terminal to catch a catamaran (speed boat) Split → Hvar. Hvar is one of the most beautiful middle Dalmatian islands, full of small sleepy towns, white stone house architecture, crystal clear sea water, Mediterranean herbs, vineyards, lavender fields, excellent wine, delicious food...

We would embark on **catamaran Split → Hvar town @7.40am**. We arrive to Hvar town @**8.45am**.

Arriving in Hvar town, first we would jump into the fisherman boat and go to 'Pakleni' archipelago. On one island we will walk around, enjoying peace and tranquility, and coffee!

If you like **swimming/snorkeling**, it can be organized. If you like cycling, **Hvar bike tour** can be organized, too. These are extra activities, organized on demand, please ask for such arrangement.

Fisherman boat will return us to Hvar town, we would be sightseeing there circa 1 hour. From Hvar we do private transfer (scenic drive) to Stari Grad town, for short sightseeing. Also, we would make brief visit to [Stari Grad plain](#) (UNESCO WH site). Finally, we'll embark on ferry Stari Grad → Split @**2:00pm**. We're back in Split @**4:00pm**. You have free time in Split in the afternoon/evening.

**Note:** lunch is not included in the tour price. It's extra, circa **25 EUR** per person.

- Transfer Zagreb → Split by car (Skoda YETI) or mini-van
- Rastoke watermill village visit (coffee)
- Plitvice Lakes NP visit (Self-guided tour)
- Day 1 – Split city walking tour
- Day 2 – Day excursion to Trogir/Primošten town
- Day 3 – Day excursion to Hvar island

- Plitvice Lakes admission fee (ticket) and guiding inside the park
- Accommodation in Split, admission fees for museums, churches, bell towers etc.
- Lunch (Day 1, Day 2, Day 3)

### **Notes:**

- Plitvice Lakes admission fee & guiding inside the park are NOT included in the tour price. In **Self-guided tour** you are provided with map, detailed walking instructions and cell phone. In **Guided tour**, there's guiding surcharge of **90 EUR**. Admission fee is extra! [Ticket prices](#)
- I can organize **wine-tasting** in Split & Hvar island, please ask for such arrangement
- I can **recommend accommodation in Split** based on your preference: hotel/private apartment
- If you plan to **visit Dubrovnik**, I can organize Dubrovnik Tour Guide partner to help you there

### **OPTIONAL: Split → Dubrovnik private scenic transfer**

If your itinerary includes **Dubrovnik**, I can transfer you by car/mini-van (scenic drive). Along the way we would stop in [Drvenik town](#) (coffee break), and in [Ston town](#) for short sightseeing. Ston town is known for its medieval walls, salt works and seafood restaurants (fresh fish and oysters).

**Transfer price: 330 EUR** for 2-3 people / **400 EUR** for 4-7 people

**Included:** transportation (scenic drive), Drvenik town (coffee), Ston town visit (sightseeing)

**Not included:** lunch in seafood restaurant. It's extra, circa **25 EUR** per person
